Re: Letter of Recommendation for Westmoreland Electric, Inc.

I am writing this letter with regard to the quality of work performed by Westmoreland Electric, Inc. (WEI). WEI was the general contractor for a PA Department of General Services funded project at the Altoona Campus of the Pennsylvania State University. At the time of this project I was the Manager of Facilities at Penn State Altoona. The project involved replacement of the existing direct buried underground 12,460 volt high voltage electrical distribution system with a new underground conduit system including cables, terminations, sectionalizing boxes, switches and various transformer replacements. I believe the project took place primarily in 2005. The construction cost of the project was approximately \$1.5 million.

WEI performance during this project was very good. Their workers were very knowledgeable and conscientious about their work. The Superintendent for the project was a very responsible young man and worked well with campus personnel to get the project completed with the least amount of interference to the operation of the campus. This project was completed with very little interruption of electrical service to any of the campus buildings and several months ahead of schedule!

I would recommend to other facility managers WEI as an electrical contractor for their campus.
