Dear Mr. DeFrancesco,

As Site Safety Engineer for Walsh Construction at the Providence Point project in Pittsburgh, Pa., I wanted to take time to review the safety efforts that occurred by your company Westmorland at our site during the construction activities.

In an attempt to benefit from lessons learned, I have reviewed documentation and safety violations for all contractors connected with this project. During this review, many things have become known and made very clear. Westmorland had limited and minor issues while at this eighteen-month project. This is a direct result of the safety attitude presented and safety enforced by your management and personnel that were assigned to this project.

All toolbox talks and equipment checks were completed and turned in on time each day. All workers and subcontractors were sent for orientation promptly when they arrived on site. All THAs were not only acceptable, but the quality improved as the project progressed, especially for critical lifts, rigging and crane operations, during transformer installations. All safety concerns that developed were addressed and corrected immediately. Many of your workers even thanked me for the correction.

I have found no record of Westmorland ever receiving any injuries or violations during the project. This appears to be due to the efforts and commitment of you and the support of your team. The obvious deep-rooted safety culture prevented injury and possibly saved lives as well as time and money on this project. This also permitted me, as safety manager, to provide more attention to contractors that required a higher level of safety maintenance with safety issues. This too may have saved lives.

As you may agree, and I am convinced that safety never occurs accidentally. It is always the result of high intention, sincere effort, intelligent direction and skillful execution. It represents the wise choice of many alternatives. Walsh Construction and I personally are looking forward to working with you, Jay Keogh, John Roddy, Russ Kuhn and the rest of your team again soon.
